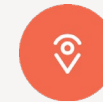

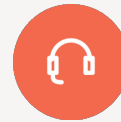
Your Insurance Team

Online portal access for digital ID cards, real-time claims view, and a full dental and vision provider network.

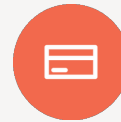
Eligibility & Enrollment

How you're enrolled, how dependents and OPT students are handled, and what payment requires.



Automatic Student Enrollment

All new international and exchange students are automatically enrolled and billed through their student account, annually or by semester.



Voluntary Dependent Enrollment

Payment links to enroll dependents are available directly on the Student Insurance website.



OPT Students

Your premium is based on the number of days you're enrolled in the plan year. Student Insurance will send you a payment link.



Payment

Payment by credit card is required to complete enrollment.

Your Welcome Email

-  Once you're enrolled, Student Insurance sends your enrollment to Administrative Concepts, Inc. (ACI).
-  You'll receive a Welcome Email containing an ACI Contact Sheet and your Digital Medical and Express Scripts Rx ID card.
-  Save it to your phone — use it for medical and/or pharmacy visits.

Claim Filing Instructions

The most efficient way to file your claim is on-line at the following secure URL:

Helpful Information for Expediting Payment:

- Complete Claim Information - ACI suggests providers submit standardized billing statements ("UB-04" for hospital charges and "CMS-1500" for Physician Charges).
- Proof of Payment — Check copy of payment, Cash Receipt, or Credit Card Statement
- Payment to Medical Providers — Unless Proof of Payment is submitted with the medical bill claim payment is sent directly to the medical providers.
- Other Insurance - If a primary insurance carrier paid a portion of your claims include the Explanation of Benefits (EOBs) with your claim submission.

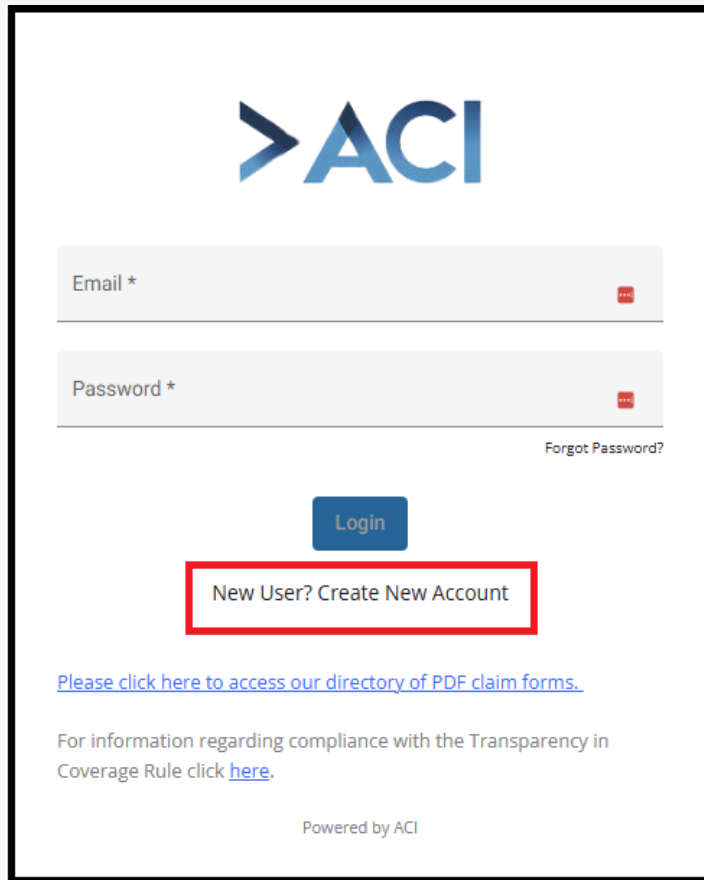

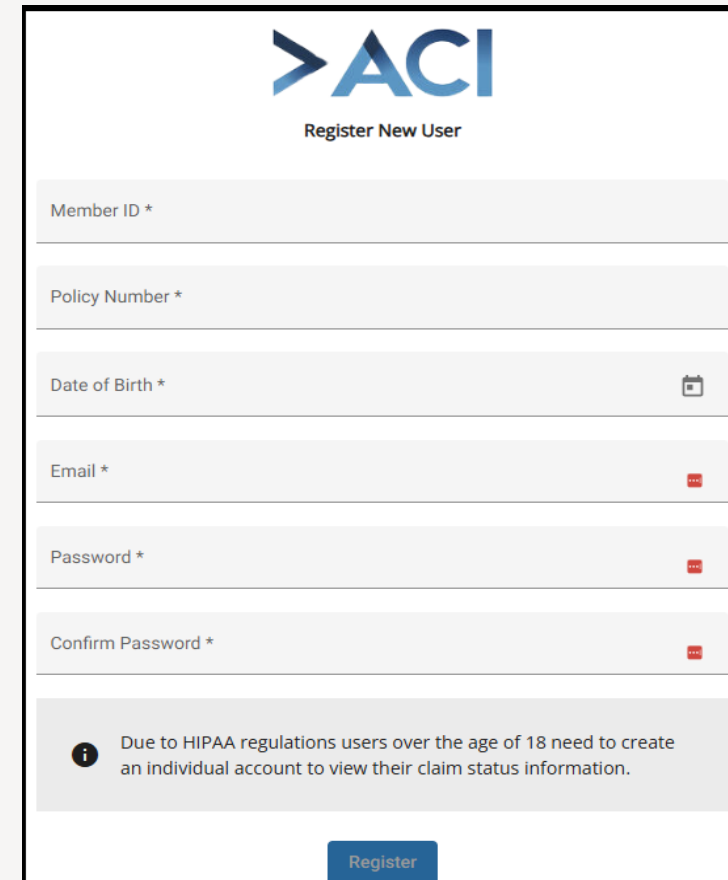

Insurance Terms to Know



Premium

The amount a student pays to have a health insurance plan.



Out-of-Pocket Maximum

What you must pay for covered, in-network care during a policy year.



Co-insurance

A fixed percentage of medical expenses payable by the student.



Co-Payment

A fixed dollar amount you pay for a specific service, like a doctor's visit or a prescription.



Policy Year

The effective dates of your policy.



Exclusions

Benefits not covered under the policy — always read your plan documents.



Insurance Terms to Know



In-Network / Preferred Care

Providers contracted with United Healthcare or Anthem. Choosing in-network means lower out-of-pocket costs.



Preferred Allowance

The fixed, negotiated rate an in-network provider agrees to accept as full payment for a covered service.



Out-of-Network / Non-Preferred Care

Providers without a contract with your carrier — expect higher out-of-pocket costs and additional charges



Usual, Reasonable & Customary (URC)

Providers contracted with United Healthcare or Anthem. Choosing in-network means lower out-of-pocket costs.

Where Can You Access Care?



Non-Urgent Medical

Student Health Services (SHS) for general care — short-term illness, low-cost immunizations, and women's health exams. SHS can refer you to another specialist as needed.



Non-Urgent Wellness

On-campus Mental Health & Wellness for crisis services, assessments, and referrals to specialists. Staff can provide crisis services and assessment of mental health needs.



Urgent, Non-Emergency

Local Urgent for faster and lower-cost than the ER. No need to wait for a scheduled appointment.



Life-Threatening Emergency

Call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room immediately.
